**Note of CROY Jacob**

More research needed. The determination that this is the likely father of Jacob, husband of Mary Huston, a confirmed descendant, is based on tax records for Cumberland, later Londonderry, Township in Bedford County, PA and the dates that the individual Croy boys appear on those records. Jacob and Richard are the first to appear. I hypothesize that Jacob was the father of the boys who then moved on when he died in about 1790 leaving his land to the oldest son Michael who first appears in the area on the 1790 census, before that likely living in All dates of births etc. are surmised based on tax, military, and other records. They would indicate that Jacob arrived during the Palatinate diaspora from the borders of the Netherlands in what is now Belgium. One record could give some credence to the possibility that the Croy's descended from a Peter Croy of 1670 Massachusetts but, because Peter is not a name passed through the generations, I have my doubts.

**Note of HUSTON Andrew**

Probably homesteaded land before 1763 but couldn't claim so due to agreement with colony and indian tribes. Proof of continuing to live in Wills Creek area from this date to death based on land warrant dated 1784 indicating homesteading from March 1, 1763. Death based on last date that both Andrews were listed in tax records since evidence is clear that Alexander's son Andrew continued to live on the land that had belonged to Alexander.

**Note of CROY Jacob**

More research needed. See spreadsheet for tax and land records for the Croys, Oswalts, and Hustons where I deduced the birthdates etc. of these families. Also see notes on Jacob Croy (1.) It is possible they are the same person. Confusion abounds as there is also evidence of a Jacob Croy in Lebanon County in the 1780's. There was a 1794 land warrant for taken out by Alexander Huston and Jacob Croy for 100 acres on the "including an improvement they now live on on Raystown Branch in Hopewell Township in the county of Huntington" PA with interest to commence from the first day of March 1775. Finally, an early Ohio land grant S29 %9 R8 4332 57 CB meaning a current resident of Columbiana County, Ohio

Mustered into Co. F 148th Infantry 5/2/1864 and out 9/14/1864 Marietta, Ohio; enlisted as a private 2/10/1865 (18) Company G, 92nd Infantry Regiment Ohio: transferred into Co. B, 31st Infantry Regiment Ohio Jun 5, 1965.

**Note of SMITH Sarah**

Obituary notes: birth, death date. Died at home of daughter, Lydia Ralph, in Pleasanton, Kansas and buried in Oklahoma. Married in Marion, Ohio 9 children 2 girls died in infancy. Gardner electrocuted in mines at Lurowerg; member of the Nazarene Church. Last words "Jesus will never forsake us or leave us alone, even until the end."
