

Outline of inhabitants of Will's Creek/Londonderry Township inhabitants from formation of Bedford County until 1786. Determined by excluding all those who were living in Evitt's Creek (Cumberland Valley) area after the formation of Londonderry Township in 1785. Focusing on surnames as they appear in area with given name of first on record in parenthesis. * indicates family that fought in rev. war in mostly Samuel Paxton's 1st Battalion.

(Andrew) **Huston***-land warrant indicates settled 1768

(Laurence) **Lamb**

(Samuel) **Rhoads**-purchased land, a developer, later Joseph Rhoads warranted land giving 1765 as date of original improvements: Some evidence of living in Somerset County. Moved to Ky 1796. Relationship to Antrim Township-Daniel born there.

1774

(William) **Devores/Devours/Devore** (Cornelius, Luke, Elijah-all*)

(Jacob) **Neimyer/Neemyer/Niemire/Nighmyer** -moved from Antrim-Little Antietam Creek

1775

(George) **Cook**-moved from Antrim-Little Antietam Creek

(Nicholas) **Lybarger/Lyberger/Liebarger*** (also Ludwick*, Henry*)

(Peter) **Buzzard***-likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset County

(Jacob) **Oswalt** (also Tobias*, Michael*)-moved from Antrim-Little Antietam Creek

(Richard) **Croy*** (also Jacob*)

(Anthony) **Asher*** -out of Maryland

(John) **Hains***

(Thomas) **Harden** -likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset County

(Benjamin) **Tomlinson/Tumelson/Tomilson** (Henry*)

(John) **Albright***

(Valentine,* Richard*, George) **Baker**

(Yost) **Ledick** (Peter*)- likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset Cty

(George) **Amrine***

(John) **Buck**- likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset Cty

(Martin*, John*, George) **Fate/Fait**

(Samuel) **Arnold*** likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset Cty

(John*,Moses*) **Porter**

(Godfrey) **Woolback*** out of Maryland

(William) **Workman*** warrant indicates settled 1776

(James, William*) **Young**- warrant indicates settled 1772

all likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset County

(Thomas) **Blackburn**-likely lived in the triangle that became Somerset County

(Peter) **Sheckley*** on rolls but never served-sick

(Jacob) **Tarwater***-moved to Tennessee in 1787
