**Note of PAYNE Samuel**

In some trees there are three additional children: Almon and Solomon born 1774 twins and Olive, born 1776...an Olive married a Mills in Vermont but could not confirm connection. Based on death of Zerah (1), and common practice of naming after a death, marriage in Maine, and family records the Sept. 1778 birth noted in Ancestry seems likely. Samuel's family had moved into early settlement of Vermont (Bennington/Sunderland area) by that time so records may have been scant.
